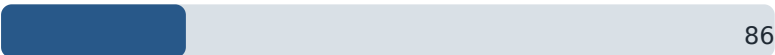

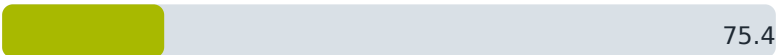

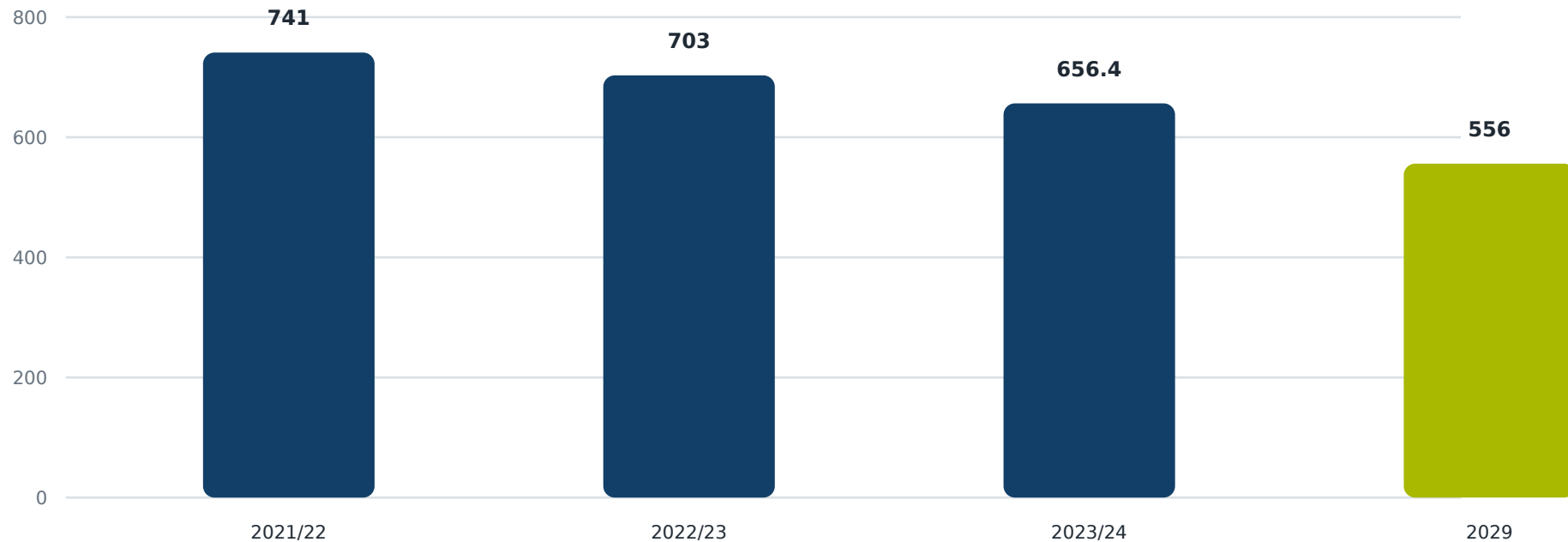
Progress

2023/24 total emissions are 656.4 tCO₂e — a reduction of 84.6 tCO₂e, or 11.4%, against the 2021/22 baseline.

Target & Progress

Target: below 556 tCO₂e by 2029

This represents a further 25% reduction from the 2021/22 baseline.



Current reported emissions: 656.4 tCO₂e | Baseline: 741 tCO₂e | Reduction achieved: 84.6 tCO₂e (11.4%).

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the 2021/22 baseline. These initiatives have contributed to a reduction of 84.6 tCO₂e, representing an 11.4% reduction against baseline emissions, and will remain in effect when performing contracts.

The measures listed below remain in effect and will continue to be applied when performing future contracts.

- Installation of LED lighting throughout facilities.
- Introduction of paperless administration systems.
- Increased use of remote conferencing to reduce travel requirements.
- Improved waste segregation and recycling processes.
- Optimisation of material usage to reduce waste generation.
- Strengthened ISO 14001 environmental management systems.
- Prioritisation of local suppliers to reduce transportation impacts.
- Ongoing factory energy efficiency improvements.

The above environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the 2021/22 baseline.

These initiatives have contributed to a reduction of 84.6 tCO₂e, representing an 11.4% reduction against baseline emissions, and will remain in effect when performing contracts.

Supplier engagement programme focused on decarbonisation.

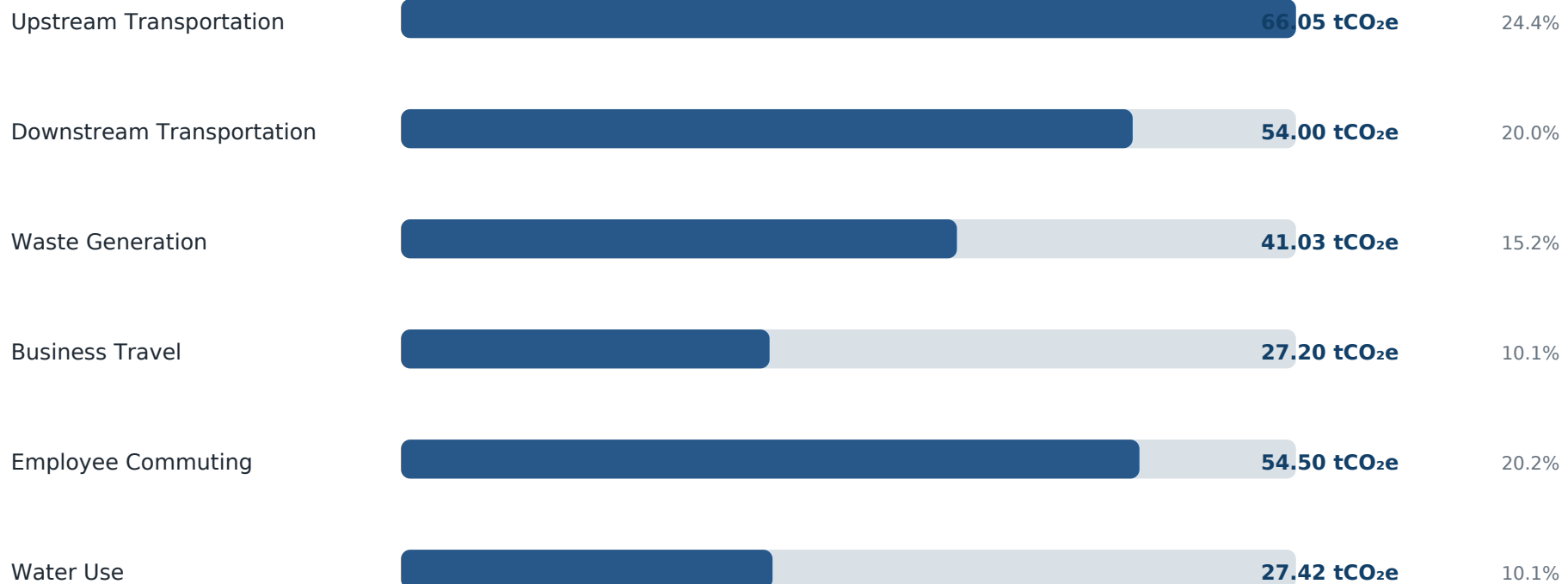

Net Zero Roadmap & Governance



Governance

- Board-level responsibility with Director sign-off.
- SHEQ Manager coordinates implementation.
- Quarterly environmental reviews.
- Suppliers are required to support reduction targets through procurement policies.

Offsetting principle

Offsets will only be considered for residual emissions after all feasible emissions reductions have been pursued.
